EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

24 HOUR ADVICE IN AN EMERGENCY ONLY: 0800 764 766

IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
Tanker/Vehicle Accident	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away and warn other traffic. Check for spills and leaks. Call the emergency services: Dial 111. If major spill occurs, evacuate all personnel upwind.
Spill or Leak	Keep all bystanders away. Wear goggles, half face piece respirator with combined dust and vapour cartridge, full length clothing and PVC gloves. Sweep up spilled product and place in sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Seek advice from local authority regarding disposal.
Fire	Immediately call the Fire Department: Dial 111. Wear PVC protective clothing and breathing apparatus. Extinguish fires with foam, dry chemical and carbon dioxide. During a fire toxic fumes may be released. Cool sealed drums with cold water to prevent rupture due to thermal expansion. Contain run-off. Keep non-involved persons away.

FIRST AID

If Swallowed:	Harmful if swallowed. Do NOT induce vomiting. Rinse mouth. If unwell call a POISON CENTRE (0800 764 766) or doctor/physician. If medical advice is needed, have product container or label at hand.
If in Eyes:	Wash eyes cautiously for 15 minutes. Remove contact lenses if they are present and it is easy to do so. Continue rinsing. If irritation persists, call a Poison Centre or doctor/physician
If on Skin:	If skin or hair contact occurs, remove all contaminated clothing and footwear. Immediately flush body with large amounts of water. Do not scrub the skin.
If Inhaled:	Remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. If ill effects persist, contact doctor or poison centre for advice.

STORAGE AND SEGREGATION SUMMARY

Storage: Store in original container in a cool, dry, ventilated place away from direct heat or sunlight. Store away from foodstuffs, animal feeds, children and animals. Keep container sealed when not in use.
