EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

24 HOUR ADVICE IN AN EMERGENCY ONLY: 0800 764 766

IF THIS HAPPENS:	DO THIS:
Tanker/Vehicle Accident:	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away and warn other traffic. Check for spills and leaks. Call the emergency services: Dial 111. If major spill occurs, evacuate all personnel upwind.
Spill or Leak:	Major spills: Call the Fire Department and alert them to the nature of the spill. Clear area of all personnel and move upwind. For minor spills, remove all ignition sources, and prevent further spillage. By any means prevent spill from entering waterways. Wearing personal protective equipment and breathing apparatus, absorb spill with inert material, and sweep up into a sealable container.
Fire:	Call the Fire Department: Dial 111. Wear protective clothing and breathing apparatus. Wear protective equipment and breathing apparatus. Extinguish with water spray (fog), foam or dry chemical powder. Do not use a water jet. Toxic fumes may be emitted.

FIRST AID

If Swallowed:	If swallowed, do NOT induce vomiting. For advice, contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately.
If in Eyes:	Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Immediately call a POISON CENTER or doctor/ physician for advice.
If on Skin:	If skin contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and flush skin with running water. If irritation occurs, seek medical advice.
If Inhaled:	If inhaled, move the victim to fresh air immediately. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

STORAGE AND SEGREGATION SUMMARY

Storage: Store locked up in original container with lid tightly closed in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area out of direct sunlight. Store away from incompatible materials, food, and seeds. Avoid physical damage to container and check regularly for leaks
