### EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

24 HOUR ADVICE IN AN EMERGENCY ONLY: 0800 764 766

IF THIS HAPPENS:	DO THIS:
<b>Tanker/Vehicle Accident:</b>	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away and warn other traffic. Check for spills and leaks. <b>Call the emergency services: Dial 111. If major spill occurs, evacuate all personnel upwind.</b>
<b>Spill or Leak:</b>	<b>Major spills: Call the Fire Department and alert them to the nature of the spill.</b> Clear area of all personnel and move upwind. For minor spills, remove all ignition sources, and prevent further spillage. By any means prevent spill from entering waterways. Wearing personal protective equipment and breathing apparatus, absorb spill with inert material, and sweep up into a sealable container.
<b>Fire:</b>	<b>Immediately call the Fire Department: Dial 111. Liquid and vapour are highly flammable. If large quantities are affected by fire, consider evacuating to 500m in all directions.</b> May be violently or explosively reactive. Wear chemical protective equipment and breathing apparatus. Extinguish with foam or dry chemical powder.

### FIRST AID

<b>If Swallowed:</b>	DO NOT induce vomiting. Rinse mouth. Avoid giving milk, oils or alcohol to drink. If unwell get medical advice/attention.
<b>If in Eyes:</b>	Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do so. Continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists: Get medical advice/attention.
<b>If on Skin:</b>	Wash with plenty of soap and water. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse.
<b>If Inhaled:</b>	Remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. If respiratory symptoms persist get medical advice / attention.

### STORAGE AND SEGREGATION SUMMARY

**Storage:** Keep out of reach of children. Store in original container with lid tightly closed in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area out of direct sunlight. Store away from incompatible materials, food, fertilizers and seeds. Avoid physical damage to container and check regularly for leaks.

**Aggregate Storage Volume Thresholds:** When storing products of the same hazard the aggregate quantity must be considered. For more information consult the current NZS8409 Management of Chemicals and the HSNO Regulations.
