**EMERGENCY PROCEDURES**

**24 HOUR ADVICE IN AN EMERGENCY ONLY: 0800 764 766**

IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
<b>Tanker/Vehicle Accident</b>	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away and warn other traffic. Check for spills and leaks. <b>Call the emergency services: Dial 111</b>
<b>Spill or Leak</b>	Prevent further migration into the environment. Prevent spilled material from flowing onto adjacent land or waterways. Use suitable material to solidify liquid. Wear protective equipment including eye protection. Collect Spillage. Large spills due to traffic accidents, etc., should be reported immediately to CHEMCALL.
<b>Fire</b>	<b>Call the Fire Department: Dial 111.</b> Wear protective clothing and breathing apparatus. May release toxic fumes under fire conditions. Contain and collect run-off (see <b>Spill or Leak</b> section above). Keep non-involved persons away.

**FIRST AID**

<b>If Swallowed:</b>	DO NOT induce vomiting. Immediately call the National Poison Centre (0800 764 766) or doctor/physician. If unresponsive, call 111 and request an ambulance. If medical advice is needed, have product container or label at hand.
<b>If in Eyes:</b>	Wash eyes cautiously for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses if they are present and it is easy to do so. Continue rinsing. Immediately call the National Poison Centre (0800 764 766) or doctor/physician.
<b>If on Skin:</b>	Remove all contaminated clothing and footwear. Immediately flush body and clothing with a large amount of soap and water, using safety shower if available. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Contact a doctor/physician if you feel unwell.
<b>If Inhaled:</b>	Remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Get medical advice/attention. If person is not breathing, call 111 and request an ambulance.

**STORAGE AND SEGREGATION SUMMARY**

**Storage:** Keep out of reach of children. Store locked up, in original container with lid tightly closed in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area out of direct sunlight, below 30°C. Avoid physical damage to container.

**Aggregate Storage Volume Thresholds:** When storing products of the same hazard the aggregate quantity must be considered. For more information consult the current NZS8409 Management of Chemicals and the HSNO Regulations.
