**EMERGENCY PROCEDURES**

**24 HOUR ADVICE IN AN EMERGENCY ONLY: 0800 764 766**

IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
<b>Tanker/Vehicle Accident</b>	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away and warn other traffic. Check for spills and leaks. <b>Call the emergency services: Dial 111</b>
<b>Spill or Leak</b>	<b>Major spills: Call the Fire Department and alert them to the nature of the spill.</b> Exclude non-essential people from the area. Wear protective clothing and prevent material such as soil, sand etc and place in waste container. Wash area with water and detergent and absorb with further inert material. Dispose of safely to an approved landfill.
<b>Fire</b>	<b>Call the Fire Department: Dial 111.</b> Wear full protective clothing and self-contained breathing apparatus. Evacuate non-essential personnel from the area to prevent human exposure to fire, smoke, fumes or products of combustion. Do not allow firefighting water to escape into waterways or sewers.

**FIRST AID**

<b>If Swallowed:</b>	Call a POISON CONTROL CENTRE or doctor/physician if you feel unwell. Rinse mouth.
<b>If in Eyes:</b>	Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do so. Continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists: Get medical advice/attention.
<b>If on Skin:</b>	Wash with plenty of soap and water. Call a POISON CONTROL CENTRE or doctor/physician if you feel unwell. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If skin irritation or rash occurs: Get medical advice/attention.
<b>If Inhaled:</b>	Immediately move to fresh air and rest. Maintain half upright position if breathing is difficult. Call a poison control centre or doctor for advice.

**Storage:** Keep out of reach of children. Store in the original, tightly closed container in a cool, dry, and well-ventilated area away from feed or foodstuffs. Avoid temperature below 5°C and above 35°C.

**Aggregate Storage Volume Thresholds:** When storing products of the same hazard the aggregate quantity must be considered. For more information consult the current NZS8409 Management of Chemicals and the HSNO Regulations.
