EMERGENCY PROCEDURES **24 HOUR ADVICE IN AN EMERGENCY ONLY: 0800 764 766**

IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
Tanker/Vehicle Accident	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away and warn other traffic. Check for spills and leaks. Call the emergency services: Dial 111
Spill or Leak	Use personal protective equipment. Use with adequate ventilation. No special precautions required. Do not flush into surface water or sanitary sewer system. Suppress (knock down) gases/vapours/mists with a water spray jet. Soak up with inert absorbent material (e.g. sand, silica gel, acid binder, universal binder, saw dust) Place in closed containers. Check label for proper disposal.
Fire	Self contained breathing apparatus, face shield or protective goggles, and neoprene rubber gloves and boots. Use water Spray, alcohol resistant foam, dry chemical powder or carbon dioxide. Prevent fire extinguishing water from contaminating surface water or the ground water system. Fire may cause evolution of carbon monoxide (CO) and carbon dioxide (CO2).

FIRST AID

If Swallowed:	Immediately call a POISON CENTRE or doctor/physician, have product container or label at hand.
If in Eyes:	Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do so, continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists: Get medical advice/attention.
If on Skin:	Wash with plenty of soap and water. Take off contaminated clothing and wash before re-use. If skin irritation persists: Get medical advice/attention.
If Inhaled:	Remove to fresh air and keep at comfortable position for breathing. Get medical advice/attention if unwell.
