EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
Tanker/Vehicle Accident	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away and warn other traffic. Check for spills and leaks. Call the emergency services: Dial 111
Spill or Leak	Wear suitable protective clothing. Restrict access to contaminated area. Contain the spill and prevent further dispersion. Place damaged containers into containment devices. Absorb spills with inert material (e.g. sand or vermiculite), and place in waste containers. Wash the area with water and absorb with further inert material. Prevent contamination of water courses or sewers.
Fire	Call the Fire Department: Dial 111. Wear protective clothing and self contained breathing apparatus. Extinguish fires with carbon dioxide, extinguishing powder or water jet. Fight larger fires with water jet or alcohol resistant foam. Fire may cause evolution of carbon dioxide, and if combustion is incomplete, carbon monoxide and smoke.

FIRST AID

If Swallowed:	Call a POISON CENTRE or doctor/physician if you feel unwell. Rinse Mouth. If medical advice is needed, have product container or label at hand.
If in Eyes:	Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do so, continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists: Get medical advice/attention.
If on Skin:	Wash with plenty of soap and water. Take off contaminated clothing and wash before re-use. If skin irritation occurs: Get medical advice/attention.
If Inhaled:	Remove to fresh air and keep at comfortable position for breathing. Get medical advice/attention if unwell.

Storage: Store below 25°C. Protect from light. Store locked up and out of reach of children.
