**EMERGENCY PROCEDURES**

**24 HOUR ADVICE IN AN EMERGENCY ONLY: 0800 764 766**

IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
<b>Tanker/Vehicle Accident</b>	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away and warn other traffic. Check for spills and leaks. <b>Call the emergency services: Dial 111</b>
<b>Spill or Leak</b>	<b>Major Spills: Call the Fire Department and alert them to the nature of the spill.</b> Evacuate personnel to safe areas. Avoid breathing in vapours or contact with skin and eyes. Wear protective gloves and face/eye protection and protective clothing. Wash the area with water and absorb spill with inert material (e.g., Vermiculite, dry sand, or earth). Put spilt material into a suitable chemical waste container and collect spillage. Prevent washings from entering waterways.
<b>Fire</b>	<b>Call the Fire Department: Dial 111.</b> Wear an approved positive pressure self-contained breathing apparatus in addition to standard firefighting gear (firefighting helmet, coat, trousers, boots, and gloves).

**FIRST AID**

<b>If Swallowed:</b>	Rinse mouth and give water to drink. DO NOT induce vomiting. If vomiting occurs give more water. Seek medical advice. Call a POISON CENTRE or doctor/physician if you feel unwell.
<b>If in Eyes:</b>	Hold eyelids apart and rinse immediately with plenty of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention if symptoms occur.
<b>If on Skin:</b>	Remove contaminated clothing. Wash skin and hair with plenty of soap and water for at least 15 minutes. If skin irritation or rash occurs: Get medical advice/attention. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse.
<b>If Inhaled:</b>	Remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Call the POISON CENTRE or doctor/physician if you feel unwell.

**STORAGE AND SEGREGATION SUMMARY**

**Storage:** Store locked up below 25°C (room temperature). Protect from light. Keep container tightly closed when not in use.
