Keep people away and warn other traffic. Check for spills and leaks. Call the Accident emergency services: Dial 111 Spill or Leak Do NOT touch or walk through spilled material. Wear PVC overalls, chemical resistant gloves, facemask or goggles. Stop leak if safe to do so. Prevent entry into waterways, drains, or confined areas. Absorb spilled product and place in sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Absorb and collect washings and place in the same sealable container for disposal. Seek advice from the local authority regarding disposal. Report large spills to Emergency Services at 0800 CHEMCALL (0800 243 622) Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. This product is combustible. Fumes and combustion products produced in a fire may be toxic and/or irritating. Small Fire: Use dry chemical, CO2, water spray or foam. Large fire: Use water fog, foam, or dry agent. If possible, use foam blanket to contain product. Avoid using AFFF. If safe to do so, move undamaged containers from fire area. Cool container with flooding quantities of water until well after fire is out. Fire **FIRST AID** Do not induce vomiting. Immediately contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or a doctor and / or If Swallowed: transport to nearest Hospital emergency ward. Take this Product Safety Card to the phone, doctor or Hospital If in Eyes: Flush eyes thoroughly with running water for 15 minutes. Remove contact lenses. If effects continue, consult a doctor or the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) If on Skin: Remove contaminated clothing and flush skin with running water. Do not scrub the skin. If Inhaled: If safe to do so, remove patient to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-nose. Get medical attention if symptoms develop. Storage: Keep out of reach of children. Store in original container with lid tightly closed in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area out of direct sunlight. Store

away from alkalis, oxidizing agents and chemicals readily decomposed by acid, food, fertilizers and seeds. Avoid physical damage to container.
