EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

24 HOUR ADVICE IN AN EMERGENCY ONLY: 0800 764 766

IF THIS HAPPENS:	DO THIS:
Tanker/Vehicle Accident:	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away and warn other traffic. Check for spills and leaks. Call the emergency services: Dial 111.
Spill or Leak:	Collect/sweep up as appropriate and contain spilt material in a plastic bag or similar. Dispose of with general refuse. Wear protective gloves and face/eye protection. Avoid entry into waterways or streams. Prevent washings from entering waterways.
Fire:	Immediately call the Fire Department: Dial 111. Liquid and vapour are highly flammable. If large quantities are affected by fire, consider evacuating to 500m in all directions. May be violently or explosively reactive. Wear chemical protective equipment and breathing apparatus. Extinguish with foam or dry chemical powder.

FIRST AID

If Swallowed:	DO NOT induce vomiting. Rinse mouth. If unwell get medical advice/attention.
If in Eyes:	Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do so. Continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists, contact a POISON CENTRE or doctor/physician.
If on Skin:	Wash with plenty of soap and water. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If skin irritation persists, contact a POISON CENTRE or doctor/physician.
If Inhaled:	Remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. If respiratory symptoms persist get medical advice/attention.

STORAGE AND SEGREGATION SUMMARY

Storage: Keep out of reach of children. Store locked up in original container with lid tightly closed in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area out of direct sunlight. Avoid physical damage to container and check regularly for leaks.
