**EMERGENCY PROCEDURES**

**24 HOUR ADVICE IN AN EMERGENCY ONLY: 0800 764 766**

IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
<b>Tanker/Vehicle Accident</b>	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away. Warn other traffic. Check for spills and leaks. <b>Call the emergency services: Dial 111</b>
<b>Spill or Leak</b>	Wear appropriate protective clothing. Absorb spills with inert material and seal bags or bottles for disposal at an approved landfill.
<b>Fire</b>	<b>Call the Fire Department: Dial 111</b> Wear protective clothing including self-contained breathing apparatus. Toxic fumes may be released. Keep people away. Extinguish fires with any suitable media.

**FIRST AID**

<b>If Swallowed:</b>	Do NOT induce vomiting. Wash mouth out with water. <b>For advice call the National Poisons Centre 0800 764 766 or a doctor immediately</b>
<b>If in Eyes:</b>	Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists: Get medical advice/attention.
<b>If on Skin:</b>	Wash affected area with soap and water. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Call a doctor or the National Poisons Centre (0800 764 766) for advice if irritation persists.
<b>If Inhaled:</b>	Immediately move to fresh air and rest. Maintain half upright position if breathing is difficult. Call a doctor or the National Poisons Centre (0800 764 766) for advice if feeling unwell.
