**EMERGENCY PROCEDURES**

**24 HOUR ADVICE IN AN EMERGENCY ONLY: 0800 764 766**

<b>IF THIS HAPPENS</b>	<b>DO THIS</b>
<b>Tanker/Vehicle Accident</b>	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills and leaks. Call the emergency services: Dial 111
<b>Spill or Leak</b>	Exclude all bystanders from the vicinity of the spill and prevent material from entering waterways. Wear appropriate protective clothing to clean up spills. Absorb spills with an inert (such as earth, sand or synthetic absorbent substance) material and place in waste containers. Wash area with water and alkaline detergent then absorb any remaining liquid with further inert material. Dispose of the waste safely in an approved landfill. Collect spillage.
<b>Fire</b>	Call the Fire Department: Dial 111. Fire fighters should wear a self-contained breathing apparatus and protective clothing to prevent contact with skin and eyes. Use foam, carbon dioxide, dry powder, water or BCF fire extinguishers. Fight fire in the early stages if it is safe to do so.

**FIRST AID**

<b>If Swallowed:</b>	Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. Call a POISON CENTRE or doctor/physician if you feel unwell.
<b>If in Eyes:</b>	Wash out immediately with water. Seek medical assistance.
<b>If on Skin:</b>	Wash with plenty of soap and water. If skin irritation or rash occurs: Get medical advice/attention. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse.
<b>If Inhaled:</b>	Remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. If not breathing apply mouth-to-mouth resuscitation. Call a POISON CENTRE or doctor/physician if you feel unwell. POISON CENTRE CONTACT: 0800 POISON

**STORAGE AND SEGREGATION SUMMARY**

**Storage:** Store in original, closed container in a cool, dry place out of direct sunlight and away from stock feed or foodstuffs. Keep containers tightly closed when not in use. Check packaging for leaks and other physical damages. Keep out of reach of children.
