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INDICATIONS For the control of sensitive mature and immature haemonchus, ostertagia. nematodirus, cooperia, trongyloides, bunostomum, oesophagostomum, chabertia that may be resistant to benzimidazole or levamisole. Also for the control of tapeworm, lungworm and adult liver fluke in cattle

Resistance can develop to any anthelmintic.

Ask your local veterinary practitioner or animal health adviser for recommended parasite management practices for your area to reduce development of resistance. It is advisable that a resistance test be conducted regularly when using any parasite treatment.

HANDLING PRECAUTIONS Harmful if swallowed. May cause an allergic skin reaction. Suspected of causing genetic defects. May damage fertility or the unborn child. May cause damage to organs. Do not exceed the stated dose volume.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE By law the user must take due care, obtaining expert advice if necessary, to avoid unnecessary pain and distress when using the product other than directed on the label.

Draft animals into lines of similar bodyweight. A representative sample of animals should be weighed before treatment. Do not underdose. Where there is a large variation in size within the group, dose rate should be based on the label directions for each weight range. Drafting into two or more lines may be appropriate, to avoid excessive overdosing. Correct drenching techniques should be used. Check accuracy of drench guns regularly.

DISPOSAL Preferably dispose of product by use. Otherwise dispose of product and packaging at an approved landfill facility. Triple rinse container. Recycle empty rinsed container at an approved recycling centre. Otherwise puncture or crush empty container and dispose of at approved landfill facility. Do not use container for any other purpose.

STORAGE Store locked up below 25°C. Away from sunlight. Do not freeze.

WITHHOLDING PERIODS It is an offence for users of this product to cause residues exceeding the relevant MRL in the Food Notice: Maximum Residue Levels for Agricultural Compounds.

MEAT: Animals producing meat or offal for human consumption must not be sold for slaughter during or within 14 days of cessation of last treatment.

MILK: Milk intended for sale for human consumption must be discarded during treatment and for not less than 35 days following the last treatment.
